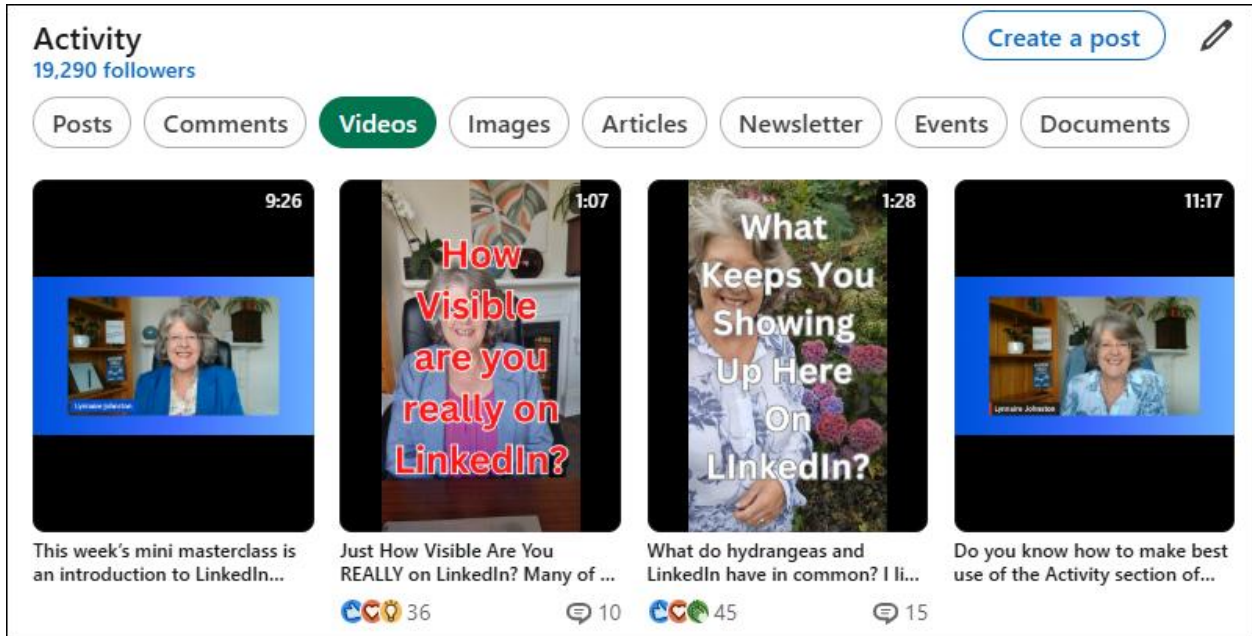

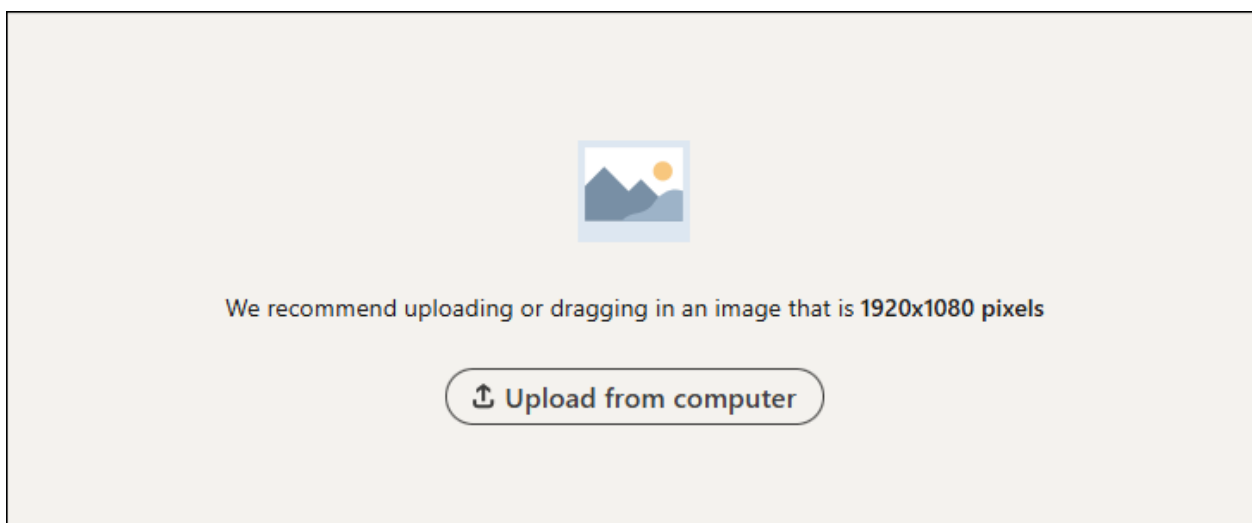
◆ Videos in Activity section of profiles become uniform size

The other option will be our normal feed. This is a test running for a month.

◆ **Search updated to include Breaking News**

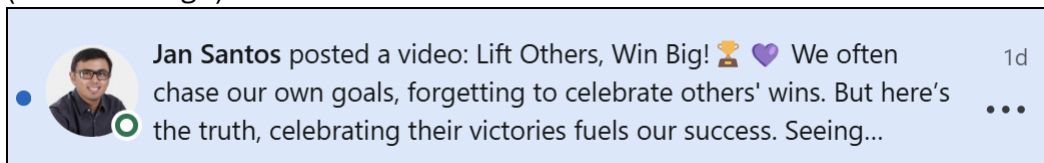
Up to 5 hyperlinked topics will show on Desktop and 10 on the app.
