#### ■ Show that you're open to volunteering



#### Sort 'Who's viewed you profile' by most recent or most relevant

When available, this will enable us to use two separate sets of analytics to follow up those who have shown interest in us and our work.

#### Amalgamation of profile intro 'More' options and Resources section

Recently, the More button in your profile intros changed to Resources. Now added to it is everything from the Resources section lower in our profiles which now disappears.






# **Posting and Newsfeed**


### ♦ Share posts to other socials, messaging apps and file saving folders

# ♦ 3 'Celebrate an occasion' templates being retired



# 'Start a post' updated to 'Share your next video or start a post'

### Choose whether to see 'Most relevant' or 'Most recent' posts on app
